







## Digital Imaging Hardware Devices

 <p>Mouse</p>	<p><b>INPUT</b></p>	<p>Used to instruct the program. 4 techniques: Point/click, right-click, drag and double-click.</p>
 <p>Keyboard</p>	<p><b>INPUT</b></p>	<p>Used to convey textual instructions to the program being used. Based on the QWERTY typewriter but has extra keys.</p>
 <p>Digital Camera</p>	<p><b>INPUT</b></p>	<p>Captures images into digital format.</p>
 <p>Scanner</p>	<p><b>INPUT</b></p>	<p>Captures images from hard copy into digital format and transfers into the computer.</p>
 <p>Printer</p>	<p><b>OUTPUT</b></p>	<p>Used to convert digital images into hard copy. Special photo paper is best for printing photos.</p>
 <p>Monitor</p>	<p><b>OUTPUT</b></p>	<p>Used to view work done on the computer.</p>
 <p>SD Card</p>	<p><b>STORAGE MEDIUM</b></p>	<p>There are other formats e.g. XD, Sony memory stick, compact Flash</p>
 <p>Flash Drive</p>	<p><b>STORAGE MEDIUM</b></p>	<p>Sometimes called Pen Drive or Memory Stick</p>
 <p>External Hard Drive</p>	<p><b>STORAGE MEDIUM</b></p>	<p>Increasingly popular as extra storage when the local hard drive inside the computer is full OR as backup for important data.</p>
