

Red Eye Tool



Red eye commonly occurs when shooting with a compact flash camera because the flash is positioned very close to the camera lens. Another situation for unavoidable red eye is in a darkly lit room where the subject's pupils are dilated.

1. Open the photo that you want to retouch
2. Click on the Red Eye tool. Adjust options if necessary.
3. If the photo is too small for an accurate placement, use the Zoom tool.
4. Click on "red eye" in your image.
5. Repeat on the other eye.

Option Bar for Red Eye



Pupil Size is the middle, preferably black area of the eye. In worse cases, reddish discoloration appears here.

Darken Amount specifies the extent of darkening to be applied.

Examples:
